Vintage Prints Thursday 8 December 2010 6.30 - 8.30 pm

Leopoldo Pomés shows here at the gallery for his very first exhibition outside Spain. Barcelona, his native city, has provided the canvas for this exceptional photographers' work since 1947. Vintage street photographs from the 1950s, portraits of artists such as Tàpies, Joan Ponç, Moses Villèlia and Eduardo Chillida and a memorable portrait of the writer Gabriel Garcia Márquez taken in the year he published *One Hundred Years of Solitude*, will all be exhibited and for sale. Bullfighting vintage prints from the 1950s originally commissioned by Ernest Hemingway and never seen before will also form part of his maiden London exhibition. Pomés will attend the show and this will be a rare opportunity to meet the artist behind the camera.
